Young researchers from Bosnia and Herzegovina in the fields of natural, technical, and mathematical sciences (STEM) held meetings on November 3rd and 4th, 2023. The Department of Technical Sciences of the Academy of Sciences and Arts of Bosnia and Herzegovina, in collaboration with the Federal Ministry of Education and Science, organized the event.

The primary goal of the conference was to establish contacts with young researchers from Bosnia and Herzegovina actively involved in STEM fields at universities and research institutions worldwide.

The conference targeted doctoral students in STEM fields and young researchers who completed their doctorates in the last five years. However, it also welcomed all interested researchers, members of the academic and scientific community in Bosnia and Herzegovina, and representatives of the Bosnian-Herzegovinian economy.

Faris Trešnjó from the Faculty of Civil Engineering at the University "Džemal Bijedić" of Mostar won the third prize for the best research presentation.

Youth Activism Trail



The Youth Council of the City of Mostar and the Association for Education and Development "Dignity" have joined forces within the ambitious project "Youth Activism Trail," which originates from a comprehensive assessment of the needs of the youth in the Herzegovina-Neretva Canton. Additionally, relevant domestic and international research supports the project.

A representative of the "Dignity" Association emphasized, "By refining 'soft skills,' young individuals have the opportunity to become catalysts for positive changes within their community. Youth are enabled to achieve personal and professional growth through active participation in social, educational, cultural, and volunteer activities. We expect this to initiate the development of their project management, teamwork, communication, and leadership skills."

The project also urges youth to develop their projects with an emphasis on social entrepreneurship, creativity, and social engagement. Through a series of workshops, educational programs, and mentorship support, the initiative will empower young people to recognize and address local challenges.

More than just a project, this initiative is a call to action that reflects a commitment to creating a sustainable community of young leaders. The "Youth Activism Trail" Initiative provides a solid platform for building a future where youth are not just observers but active participants in shaping positive changes in their environment.
