

Academic year starts on October 1 and ends on September 30 of the following year. It is organized in two semesters. Winter semester starts in the first week of October and ends in the mid January and summer semester starts in last week of February and ends in the first week of June.

One study semester equals 30 ECTS for each study cycles.

Number of ECTS is determined based on the total time the student was engaged on a specific subject, such as

- lectures (theory or/and practise, exercises, seminar papers, etc.),
- tasks (homework, projects, research work, etc.),
- studying for the exams (tests, final exam, etc).

The sum of 60 ECTS is equal to average total engagement of student during the 40 working week hours in one academic year.

The student's score is expressed as alpha-numerical or descriptive from the lowest to the highest grade as it follows:

- a) grade 5 (five), descriptive "not sufficient", in characters "F", under 55 points;
- b) grade 6 (six), descriptive "sufficient", in characters "E", from 55 to 64 points;
- c) grade 7 (seven), descriptive "good", in characters "D", from 65 to 74 points;
- d) grade 8 (eight), descriptive "very good", in characters "C", from 75 to 84 points;
- e) grade 9 (nine), descriptive "extraordinary", in characters "B", from 85 to 94 points;
- f) grade 10 (ten), descriptive "excellent", in characters "A", from 95 to 100 points.
