On that day in 1943, the AntiFascist Council of National Liberation of Bosnia and Herzegovina (Anobit), at its first session, adopted the Resolution of ZAVNOBiH. The Resolution expressed the determination of the people of Bosnia and Herzegovina for their country to be a community where all people should be equal as well as the equality of then the Peoples' Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina within then Yugoslavia with historical borders dating back to medieval Bosnia.
