
May Day, also called Workers' Day or International Workers' Day, is the day when people around the world remember the historic struggles and gains made by workers and the labor movement.

May Day has been recognized as a public holiday, and it continues to be celebrated with picnics and parties while serving as the occasion for demonstrations and rallies in support of workers.


Erasmus experience: Zeynep Nur Yildiz


