90TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE BIRTH OF WRITER AND INTELLECTUAL PREDRAG MATVEJEVIĆ

The 90th anniversary of the birth of Predrag Matvejevć, Mostar and Bosnia and Herzegovina writer and intellectual, and recipient of an honorary doctorate of the Dzemal Bijedic University of Mostar, was marked with an appropriate program at the Mostar Culture Center.

Historian Dragan Markovina, communication specialist Dario Terzić, and professor at the Department of Bosnian Language and Literature of the Faculty of Humanities, prof. dr. Irma Marić participated in the program marking the anniversary of Matvejević's birth.

In her presentation, Professor Marić emphasized the poetic originality and knowledge of cultural and historical paradigms that made Predrag Matvejević one of the most recognizable and significant South Slavic essayists and experts on cultural and anthropological issues.

Professor Marić highlighted that Predrag Matvejević is one of the most translated authors with an enouromus influence on the cultural and historical trends of European literature.

Predrag Matvejević was born on October 7, 1932, and died in February 2017. After finishing elementary and secondary school in his native Mostar, he began studying Roman literature in Sarajevo and completed it in Zagreb. In 1967, he received his doctorate at Sorbonne University in Paris.
